We recommend a maximum of 2 extra activities to avoid heavy conflicts with your child's timetable.

All lessons are for 35 minutes unless stated otherwise.

At least 3 pupils are required for group lessons, if the number reduces below 3 the cost of the lessons will increase to the shared/individual lesson cost.

Pupils' own riding hats must contain the safety code PAS015 2011 with BSI Kitemark or Snell E2016 onwards with official label and number, and be correctly fitting. Body protectors be 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Contact the Finance Department to obtain an application form.
2. Complete the application form and return it to luctonextras@luctonschool.org. Completion of the form should only be undertaken once you have read and agreed to the terms set out herein.
3. Pupils should enroll at the beginning of term or at half term.
4. The price is per term and is based on 30 lessons over the school year, although as some terms are longer than others, these may not be evenly distributed by term.
5. We will endeavor to invoice you in advance each term.
6. Pupils are responsible for finding out the time and day of each lesson and should arrive punctually.
7. Pupils are responsible for letting their teacher or School Office know in advance if they are going to be absent, for whatever reason. Individual lessons may be rearranged if possible.
8. If pupils are absent through illness, parents must notify the School Office so that we can inform the teacher concerned; the normal fee for the missed lesson will still apply.
9. All group music lessons are to be a minimum of 3. Shared lessons will be negotiated with the DoM. Group lessons will be dependent on a willingness from all students to participate, if group members drop out of the scheme (leaving 1-2 students) the group rate cannot continue. If numbers reduce below 3, the cost of the lessons will increase to £125 per pupil/term if 2 pupils, with a half term's notice.
10. All group EAL lessons are to be a minimum of 3 pupils. If the numbers reduce below 3, the cost of the lessons will increase to £250 per pupil/term.
11. All individual lessons are for one pupil at a time.
12. A full half term's notice in writing is required to cease lessons; this must be given to the School Office in the first instance. Occasional Boarding (£50 per night), after school care up to 6pm (£7.00 including tea) and after school care up to 7pm (£14 including tea) are also available on an ad hoc basis – please enquire via the School Office in the first instance. 24 hours' notice, from a parent or guardian, is required for Occasional Boarding, ideally by email (office@luctonschool.org) or letter.
